<sup>1</sup>Children, **obey** your parents in the Lord, for this is right. <sup>2</sup>"**Honor** your father and mother"—which is the first commandment with a promise— <sup>3</sup>"that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth." <sup>4</sup>Fathers, do not **exasperate** your children; instead, bring them up in the **training and instruction** of the Lord.

<sup>5</sup>...her husband has **full** confidence in [the wife of noble character] and **lacks nothing** of value. <sup>6</sup>She brings him good, not harm, all the days of her life.
