and that sin separates us from Him. (Isaiah 59:2)



for sin is death. (Romans 6:23)

If we don't deal with our sin before we die,
we end up in hell. (Matthew 13:49-50)

We try to make things right with God by doing good works, but those good works are never enough to pay the death penalty for our sin.

Our good works always fall short of God's perfect standard. (Ephesians 2:8-9)


The solution is that God sent His Son Jesus to die on the cross and pay the death penalty for us, so that we don't have to pay it ourselves. (Romans 5:8)

We respond to Jesus by making up our minds to turn from sin, and believe in Jesus for salvation and eternal life. (Mark 1:15, John 3:16)

When we turn from
our sins and believe in
God's Son, Jesus Christ,
three things happen:

1) Our sins are forgiven

2) We begin a close personal relationship with God

3) His Holy Spirit comes to live in us
