

## **God Sent His Son Jesus To Die In Our Place**

“For Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, that he might bring us to God” - 1 Peter 3:18

“But God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.” - Romans 5:8

God's love and justice were both demonstrated at the cross. Jesus, as our substitute, willingly suffered the punishment that we deserve. Because he died in our place and rose again, we can have forgiveness and eternal life as a free gift.

**Does Everyone Receive  
The Gift Of Eternal Life?**

**Only Those Who Repent And Believe In  
Jesus Christ Receive Eternal Life In Heaven.**

Repentance is a firm decision to turn from sin and to turn toward God. True repentance is a change of mind that results in a change in direction.

“...the kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel.” - Jesus (Mark 1:15)

“Repent therefore, and turn back, that your sins may be blotted out” - Acts 3:19

“For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.” - John 3:16

## **True Believing Is More Than Just An Intellectual Understanding Of Facts.**

True faith involves a realization that:

- I have broken God's laws and deserve His judgment.
- There is nothing I can do to remove the guilt and penalty of my sin.
- The death and resurrection of Jesus Christ is the only solution for my sin.

## **You Must Make A Deliberate Choice To Receive Jesus Christ As Your Lord And Savior**

“...his own people did not receive him. But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God” - John 1:11-12

If you would like to repent, believe in Jesus, and receive him as your savior, you can simply talk to God expressing:

1. I am a sinner. I want to turn from sin and turn to you.
2. I believe that the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ is the only solution for my sin.
3. I receive Jesus Christ as my Lord and Savior.
4. Please forgive me for my sin, take control of my life, and make me the person that you want me to be.
