

#### 2017: Looking Forward to a Year of Growing

At Darby Creek Church, we want to grow numerically and spiritually. In church circles some people might say, "we don't care about the numbers of people". I think I understand what people mean by saying those types of things. However, if more people hear the gospel message of Jesus, then more people become Christ-followers. That is numerical growth and we know that God is glorified when people come to saving faith in Christ and His Kingdom influence spreads. So, in this sense, numbers matter.

Why this talk of numbers? Simply put: because we want to grow our church here at Darby Creek. Not for growth's sake. Not so we can say, "look how big we are". We want to grow because God is glorified through people coming to faith and following Him. We know that God saves people and He builds His church. But we know that we have a part in this church growth process and if we choose not to do our part – and do our level best at our part - then we won't experience the blessings that could come from it. With that said, here are four things I would like us all to take to heart this year as we take aim at doing our best at growing our church for God's glory:



(Romans 12:1; Ephesians 6:19; Acts 4:31).

Go to God: We need to have a culture of desperation. When we realize only God can ultimately save people and only God can change us into the church He wants us to be, then we are driven to desperate prayer. Prayer is the first and most important aspect of any church growing. Pray for our church privately, in small groups, and attend our monthly prayer meetings. Pray for your own personal gospel-sharing boldness

Relate in Christ-like Love: Darby Creek has always been characterized as a friendly and loving church. That is a wonderful strength God has given us. However, we should not take it for granted. We must continue to pursue unity with each other. We need to deal with relational conflict quickly. Excel in serving each other and loving one

another with a love that others see and to which they are drawn (John 13:34-35; Acts 2:44-45).

**Own the Great Commission:** We know that faith comes through hearing the gospel of Jesus Christ. People need to know Christians and see them in action, but they also need a verbal witness of the gospel. We need to be loving and bold with sharing Christ and what He has done for us. The commission that Jesus gave in Matthew 28:19-20 was for ALL believers. We need to own that and take action by being prepared to share our faith and then delivering the message. Do you have relationships with people who don't know Christ? Do you know how to share your personal testimony with others in a few minutes time? This is all part of owning Jesus' commission to make disciples.



Work on Excelling: This is mostly a church-wide challenge to examine our ministries and our church service to make sure we are doing our best. Our Elders are thinking through our church service and ministries and asking questions like: What can we do better in our Sunday service to make it more effective for the sake of the gospel? How can we "excel still more" in each ministry we have at Darby Creek. As a volunteer at Darby Creek you could ask, "Am I giving God my best in the ministries where I'm serving". Are there ways you could "improve your serve" for the glory of God and for the advancement of His Kingdom?

I appreciate your prayers, cooperation, and feedback as we take aim at 2017 and look forward to a year of pursing growth for the glory of God.

#### Wrapping Up 2016

Here are a few items I think will be of interest to you that have come across my "Pastor's Desk" as we end 2016 and move into 2017:

\*Name Change Effective January 1, 2017: Our church name is officially changing on January 1, 2017 to Darby Creek Church. We are switching for two main reasons. One is so we won't be confused with the "Community Church" denomination. The other is because Darby Creek Church is just shorter and easier to remember. All of our print materials and digital media are getting the new name and logo. Feel free to pick up an updated church invite near the church bulletin board in the sanctuary!

\*Charley and I are Switching to Reliant for Health Insurance Purposes: Pastor Charley and myself are switching our payroll and health insurance from Darby Creek to Reliant (https://reliant.org). Reliant is the new name for Great Commission Ministries (some of you may recognize that name) which has provided payroll and fundraising services as well as health insurance plans for many pastors and missionaries all over the world. Our health insurance premiums, like most everyone else's, have continued to skyrocket and we needed to do something to Ohelp our church move towards a balanced budget. Making this change will save our church close to \$500 per month. The health benefits through Reliant are basically the same as Charley and I are receiving now but for a lower premium. We hope to have this switchover completed by March 15 payroll. Technically, Charley and I will be Reliant employees and Darby Creek Church will be our single donor. A number of pastors have done this in Great Commission Churches including John Hopler.

**Deadline for \$10 deposit for Nicaragua Missions Trip:** In order to solidify who is going on our missions trip to Managua, Nicaragua scheduled for June 17 thru 24, we have set Sunday, January 8, 2017 as the first deadline for making a financial deposit. If you are planning on going on the trip, please put a \$10 check in the offering basket with "2017 Managua Missions Trip" in the memo field or you can mail the funds in as well (electronic giving is also accepted using PayPal or Chase Quick-Pay). We are looking forward to see what God will do on this next trip to serve along side our sister church in Managua. 
