1 CORINTHIANS 4:1-5 ESV

- 1 This is how one should regard us, as servants of Christ and stewards of the mysteries of God.
- 2 Moreover, it is required of stewards that they be found faithful.
- 3 But with me it is a very small thing that I should be judged by you or by any human court. In fact, I do not even judge myself.



1 CORINTHIANS 4:1-5 ESV

4 For I am not aware of anything against myself, but I am not thereby acquitted. It is the Lord who judges me.

5 Therefore do not pronounce judgment before the time, before the Lord comes, who will bring to light the things now hidden in darkness and will disclose the purposes of the heart. Then each one will receive his commendation from God.





1. UNDERSTAND THE ROLE OF MINISTRY

* The role of ministry is to be a SERVANT of Jesus by being FAITHFUL with what has been ENTRUSTED to you.

1 CORINTHIANS 4:1-2 ESV

- 1 This is how one should regard us, as **servants** of **Christ** and **stewards** of the mysteries of God.
- 2 Moreover, it is required of stewards that they be found <u>faithful</u>.



MATTHEW 25:20-21 ESV

20 And he who had received the five talents came forward, bringing five talents more, saying, 'Master, you delivered to me five talents; here, I have made five talents more.'

21 His master said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant. You have been faithful over a little; I will set you over much. Enter into the joy of your master.'





2. KNOW WHO EVALUATES YOUR MINISTRY AND WHEN THAT TAKES PLACE

- * Having a proper evaluation of your ministry depends on WHO is evaluating and WHEN the evaluation takes place.
- * The LORD will give your ministry evaluation and it will take place after Jesus returns.

1 CORINTHIANS 4:3-5 ESV

3 But with me it is a very small thing that I should be judged by you or by any human court. In fact, I do not even judge myself.

4 For I am not aware of anything against myself, but I am not thereby acquitted. It is the Lord who judges me.

5 Therefore do not pronounce judgment before the time, before the Lord comes, who will bring to light the things now hidden in darkness and will disclose the purposes of the heart. Then each one will receive his commendation from God.
