WHEN HE WAS AT TIRZAH, DRINKING HIMSELF DRUNK IN THE HOUSE OF ARZA, WHO WAS OVER THE HOUSEHOLD IN TIRZAH,

NOW THE TROOPS WERE ENCAMPED AGAINST GIBBETHON, WHICH BELONGED TO THE PHILISTINES, 1 KINGS 16:15-19 (ESV) <sup>16</sup>AND THE TROOPS WHO WERE ENCAMPED HEARD IT SAID, "ZIMRI HAS CONSPIRED, AND HE HAS KILLED THE KING." THEREFORE ALL ISRAEL MADE OMRI, THE COMMANDER OF THE ARMY, KING OVER ISRAEL THAT DAY IN THE CAMP.
