2: Beware of the comparison trap

<sup>18</sup>Truly you set them in slippery places; you make them fall to ruin.

<sup>19</sup>How they are destroyed in a moment, swept away utterly by terrors!

<sup>20</sup>Like a dream when one awakes, O Lord, when you rouse yourself, you despise them as phantoms.

<sup>18</sup>For many, of whom I have often told you and now tell you even with tears, walk as enemies of the cross of Christ.

<sup>19</sup>Their end is destruction, their god is their belly, and they glory in their shame, with minds set on earthly things.

<sup>20</sup>But our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we await a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ,

<sup>21</sup>who will transform our lowly body to be like his glorious body, by the power that enables him even to subject all things to himself.
