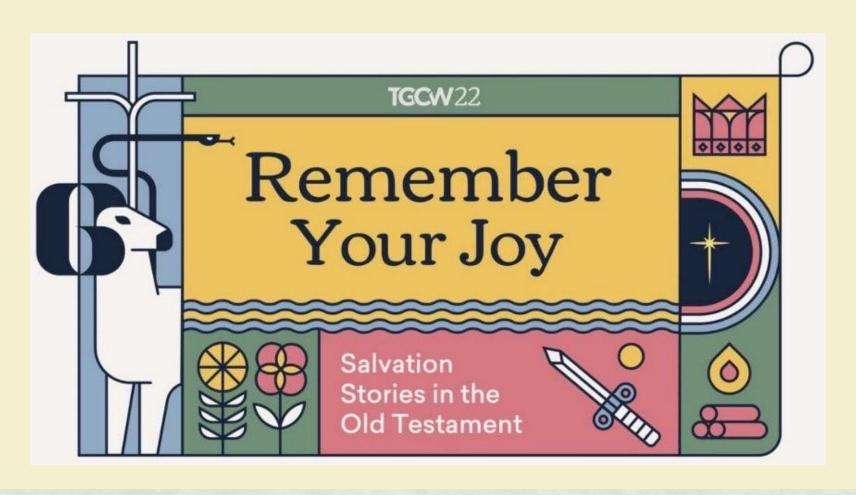

### Improving Coordinated Care of Those in Need

- Appointing Deacon(s) / Deaconess(es) to help our Elders care for those in need of assistance at DCC.
- This would help coordinate care
  - · Sometimes an individual sees a need and takes care of it
  - Sometimes a person's small group is able to meet the need
  - Sometimes the larger body needs to be involved in helping (meal trains, signing up to serve those in need, etc.)
  - Sometimes the church can help financially to assist when necessary (Needs Fund)



### Reaching Out

- Reaching Out to Families
  - MOPS Mothers of Preschoolers: Starting in September!
  - VBS Vacation Bible School: This coming summer!
- General Outreach
  - More Blues Jams

DCC Planning & Building Committee
Update 9-9-22



The following plan is a journey to take us as a church to our 2035 vision. In order to take the Church into the coming decades, some funds spent in the fifteen-year plan and updates to the Church Building will disappear into that new design. Doing improvements in this way keeps the present-day Church attractive and growing into 2035 for the future Church and future Church body.

#### Plan is divided in 3 Sectional Time Frames

#### 1: Gravel Driveway and Shed Repair

- Estimated Cost: \$1,000
- Level off the parking lot with new gravel.
- Repair shed for mower storage to store mower.

#### 2: Ceiling Tile Repair

- Estimated Cost:
  - Sanctuary: \$50
  - Kick Rooms: \$1,000
  - Please hold off on Fellowship hall until we determine what we are doing with the baptismal area.

# 4: Driveway Entrance, Concrete Pad & Asphalt Drive to Handicapped Area

- Estimated Cost: \$12,500
- Purpose is added Safety & Hospitality
- Note: Just doing this part and not the entire lot due to watershed & zoning issues
- Get detailed quotes for Late Spring 2020.

#### 5: Outside appearance of Church

- Estimated Cost: \$20,000
- The Church would be more attractive and less commercial/agricultural in appearance.



### In Process

#### 6: Church Lobby/Patio Area

- Estimated Cost: \$20,000
- The Church would be more visually appealing, a better area to welcome people to God's house
- Possible large project to do at the same time as the fellowship Hall and Kick projects.





## 7: Remove Baptismal & Upgrade Kick Classrooms

- Estimated Cost: \$10,000
- Better use of space and more welcoming to new families
- For time being, purchase of an Inflatable Baptismal (\$500)
- Sell the baptismal
- Possible large project to do at the same time as the fellowship Hall and Kick projects.





#### 8: Church Shelter House

- Estimated Cost: \$22,000
- The Church would have a space for Community Events
  - Picnics, Recycling Center, Fall Festival, among other community outreaches





## 9: Windows for Interior Doors with People in the Room

- Estimated Cost: \$1,000
- Safety and Visibility

#### 10: New Carpet & Chairs

- Estimated Cost: \$10,000
- General Upkeep





#### 11: Contingency Plan

- Estimated Cost: \$10,000
- Repairing and Replacing of well, hot water heater, softener, furnace, etc.

#### 1: Kitchen Replacement

- Estimated Cost: \$15,000
- Need of replacement for better fellowship





# 2: New Stage to the North of Original Building

- Estimated Cost: \$10,000
- Need to make more room to meet maximum occupancy of 250 in sanctuary





#### 3: Driveway/Parking Lot Full Replacement

- Estimated Cost: \$37,000
- Note: Major paperwork watershed and zoning issues.





#### 4: Screened Prayer Gazebo

- Estimated Cost: \$2,500.00
- A place to go for prayer and quiet time





#### 2030 Summary:

- 1. Kitchen Replacement \$15,000
- 2. New Stage to the North of Original Building \$10,000
- 3. Driveway/Parking Lot Full Replacement \$37,000
- 4. Screened Prayer Gazebo \$2,500

**Total Plan Estimated Cost: \$64,500** 



#### Proposed Idea #1: Remodel of Current Church

- Estimated Cost: \$200,000-\$500,000
- Move Sanctuary to the west side of original building





#### Proposed Idea #2: Buy/Build New Church

- Estimated Cost: \$1,500,000
- Build on new property and sell old building
