²²And when the time came for their purification according to the Law of Moses, they brought him up to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord

²³(as it is written in the Law of the Lord, “Every male who first opens the womb shall be called holy to the Lord”)

**The salvation that Jesus brings is the
fulfillment of God's promise (vss 25-26)**

THE GOSPEL OF LUKE

Luke 2:25-26 (ESV)

²⁵Now there was a man in Jerusalem, whose name was Simeon, and this man was righteous and devout, waiting for the consolation of Israel, and the Holy Spirit was upon him.

THE GOSPEL OF LUKE

²⁶And it had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death before he had seen the Lord's Christ.

**The salvation Jesus brings gives peace to
those who receive it (vs 2:29)**

THE GOSPEL OF LUKE

²⁹“Lord, now you are letting your servant depart in peace, according to your word;

³⁰for my eyes have seen your salvation

THE GOSPEL OF LUKE

This salvation would be for ALL people (31-32)

THE GOSPEL OF LUKE

Luke 2:31-32 (ESV)

³¹that you have prepared in the presence of all peoples,

THE GOSPEL OF LUKE

Luke 2:31-32 (ESV)

³²a light for revelation to the Gentiles,
and for glory to your people Israel.”

This salvation would not go unopposed (2:33-35)
