## Luke 7:1-10 (ESV)

<sup>1</sup>After he had finished all his sayings in the hearing of the people, he entered Capernaum.

## Luke 7:1-10 (ESV)

<sup>2</sup>Now a centurion had a servant who was sick and at the point of death, who was highly valued by him.

## Luke 7:1-10 (ESV)

<sup>3</sup>When the centurion heard about Jesus, he sent to him elders of the Jews, asking him to come and heal his servant.

<sup>4</sup>And when they came to Jesus, they pleaded with him earnestly, saying, “He is worthy to have you do this for him,

<sup>5</sup>for he loves our nation, and he is the one who built us our synagogue.”

<sup>7</sup>Therefore I did not presume to come to you. But say the word, and let my servant be healed.

<sup>8</sup>For I too am a man set under authority, with soldiers under me: and I say to one, 'Go,' and he goes; and to another, 'Come,' and he comes; and to my servant, 'Do this,' and he does it."

## Luke 7:1-10 (ESV)

<sup>9</sup>When Jesus heard these things, he marveled at him, and turning to the crowd that followed him, said, “I tell you, not even in Israel have I found such faith.”

<sup>10</sup>And when those who had been sent returned to the house, they found the servant well.

## Luke 7:11-17 (ESV)

<sup>11</sup>Soon afterward he went to a town called Nain, and his disciples and a great crowd went with him.

## Luke 7:11-17 (ESV)

<sup>12</sup>As he drew near to the gate of the town, behold, a man who had died was being carried out, the only son of his mother, and she was a widow, and a considerable crowd from the town was with her.



## Luke 7:11-17 (ESV)

<sup>13</sup>And when the Lord saw her, he had compassion on her and said to her, “Do not weep.”

## Luke 7:11-17 (ESV)

<sup>14</sup>Then he came up and touched the bier, and the bearers stood still. And he said, “Young man, I say to you, arise.”

## Luke 7:11-17 (ESV)

<sup>15</sup>And the dead man sat up and began to speak, and Jesus gave him to his mother.

## Luke 7:11-17 (ESV)

<sup>16</sup>Fear seized them all, and they glorified God, saying, “A great prophet has arisen among us!” and “God has visited his people!”

<sup>17</sup>And this report about him spread through the whole of Judea and all the surrounding country.
