## Colossians 1:15-17 (ESV)

**<sup>16</sup>For by him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things were created through him and for him.**





## Colossians 1:15-17 (ESV)

**<sup>17</sup>And he is before all things, and in him all things hold together.**

## Matthew 4:23-24 (ESV)

**<sup>23</sup>And he went throughout all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom and healing every disease and every affliction among the people.**

**<sup>24</sup>So his fame spread throughout all Syria, and they brought him all the sick, those afflicted with various diseases and pains, those oppressed by demons, those having seizures, and paralytics, and he healed them.**
