Judge

- Doesn't know the woman
- No personal interest in the woman
- Gives no access
- Isn't fair
- Answers only out of self-interest

VS

God

- Knows the woman deeply
- Loves and cares for those that cry out to Him
- Gives constant access
- Is just and loves everyone
- Answers only out of what's best for us
