¹⁵Yet she will be saved through childbearing—if they continue in faith and love and holiness, with self-control.

What is clear from verse 15?



**** A Christian woman will be saved**



1 Timothy 2:14 (ESV)

¹⁴and Adam was not deceived, but the woman was deceived and became a transgressor.



**** True Christian women will continue in faith and show evidence of saving faith**



Philippians 2:12-13 (ESV)

¹²Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, so now, not only as in my presence but much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling,



Philippians 2:12-13 (ESV)

¹³for it is God who works in you, both to will and to work for his good pleasure.



James 2:14-16 (ESV)

¹⁴What good is it, my brothers, if someone says he has faith but does not have works? Can that faith save him?



James 2:14-16 (ESV)

¹⁵If a brother or sister is poorly clothed and lacking in daily food,



James 2:14-16 (ESV)

¹⁶and one of you says to them, "Go in peace, be warmed and filled," without giving them the things needed for the body, what good is that?



What is unclear from verse 15?



**** What does "saved through
childbearing" mean?**



1: Christian women will be **physically**
preserved (saved) through child birth



2: Christian women secure their own
spiritual salvation through bearing children



Ephesians 2:8-9 (ESV)

⁸For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God,



Ephesians 2:8-9 (ESV)

⁹not a result of works, so that no one may boast.



3: Christian women will be saved through
"THE Child" (Jesus) who was born to Mary



Galatians 4:4 (ESV)

⁴But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law,



4: A Christian woman's salvation is evidenced by living a godly life which includes living according to her God-ordained role



5: A Christian woman will be saved through
the fiery trial of childbirth if she continues
in faith and living a godly life



Genesis 3:16 (ESV)

¹⁶To the woman he said,

“I will surely multiply your pain in childbearing;
in pain you shall bring forth children.

Your desire shall be contrary to your husband,
but he shall rule over you.”



1 Corinthians 3:15 (ESV)

¹⁵If anyone's work is burned up, he will suffer loss, though he himself will be saved, but only as through fire.

Galatians 3:26-29 (ESV)

²⁶for in Christ Jesus you are all sons of God, through faith.



Galatians 3:26-29 (ESV)

²⁷For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ.



Galatians 3:26-29 (ESV)

²⁸There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is no male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus.



Galatians 3:26-29 (ESV)

²⁹And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's offspring, heirs according to promise.
